The BPC Citizen Science team is composed of individuals of all ages and walks of life who are assigned a pond where they gather water samples bi-weekly from May through October. You'll have fun learning about our ponds and working with your team. Most importantly, you will be serving the community with important news about the health of Brewster's ponds.



Assist with our Brewster elementary schools Pond Education Program. The Pond Education Team provides 2nd and 5th grade teachers with grade appropriate pond kits which include detailed curriculum guides, lesson plans, classroom activities, games, crafts and reference materials, culminating in end of year field trips to a Brewster pond. The Events Team plans, coordinates and oversees all of the BPC events that serve to educate the Brewster community and beyond for the protection and improvement of our ponds.
